Deepen and further decentralize the structures of governance and empower our community to hold public officers accountable; offer efficient and proximate services; Entrench the practice of public participation in formulation, prioritization, review and implementation of development programs. My commitment and that of my administration will be to have devolution deliver to the people of Kisii County.

PILLAR 2 WEALTH CREATION


Pursue economic empowerment programs geared towards poverty eradication and improved livelihood. This will include – offering the best financial services as the hub of our region, operationalizing the 24-hour economy in the municipalities and townships and expanding the retail and hospitality services.


We want to expand employment opportunities by financing the installation of cottage industry machinery, revamping the agricultural sector by reviving the coffee, pyrethrum and other products and linking Kisii to the world markets.

My administration will jumpstart the manufacturing and business engine and turbo-charge it through targeted investments in the sugar, tea and coffee sub-sectors to ensure maximum returns possible to farmers, promote value addition to our bananas, avocados, sugarcane, pineapples, pyrethrum and the development of cottage industries.

Similarly, we will promote and pursue initiatives that will lead to Job creation in various sectors (Kazi Mashinani) through establishment of business innovation and incubation centres that promote entrepreneurship.

Access to markets and marketing through the establishment of aggregation centres, restructuring and development of markets starting with Daraja Mbili & Marikiti, Suneka, Nyakoe, Mogonga, Etago, Nyanguso, Keroka, Nyamache, Magena, Ogembo,





Mosocho, Masimba, Marani and Kegogi will be a priority in this pillar.

We shall put focus on Infrastructure development to open up the rural economy; pursue sustainable agriculture development in livestock, poultry, fisheries and crop farming, supporting small-scale farmers and access to modern farming technologies and other inputs. We shall promote feasible Land use programs by undertaking practical physical planning and urban development plans and also support access to cheaper, reliable and sustainable energy sources to all.

PILLAR 3 SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION


Recognizing that the economy of Kisii County depends on the state natural and environmental resources, my administration will utilize and protect our environment and associated natural resources sustainably by: introducing innovative and participatory management of water towers notably hilltops throughout our county; encourage the planting of indigenous trees that are friendly to other land use practices, reclaim and protect the riparian land, wetlands and conserve our Nyangweta forest. Maintain clean urban areas by establishing modern ecofriendly municipal waste and sewerage management system that will be a model example to bench mark; establish a permanent solution to the rain water and drainage system. We shall endeavor to improve robustly our education programs

in Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE), Vocational training, Village Polytechnics and Home craft through infrastructure development, equipping the centres with modern state-of-the-art facilities; hiring highly qualified and motivated tutors on improved terms of service.

PILLAR 4 & 5

OUR PILLARS FOR DEVELOPMENT



Promote access to secondary and tertiary education through a reformed County Bursary Scheme; Innovation and skills development in our vocational centres, academic performance in our schools and promotion of social human capital through empowerment programs targeting youths, women.

Provision of superior Universal Healthcare Services will be an exigency in our administration. We shall invest substantially in diagnostic, preventive, and curative measures by equipping our hospitals and health facilities with modern medical equipment and essential medicines. Hiring and training of professional healthcare givers and digitalization of all processes and procedures will be a priority.

Provision of clean, safe and reliable water for domestic, urban, agricultural and industrial use will be a priority. Similarly, we will pursue enhanced social protection programs notably the **Simba Shelter Scheme** that will be delivering reliable rural housing schemes and eliminating completely grass thatched houses and dilapidated structures. My administration shall also establish new urban housing schemes for urban populace in addition to an effective social welfare program for the elderly.

Talent development through promotion of sports, culture and arts, Rehabilitation & Rescue programmes for the vulnerable and Skills Development Centres for the destitute and homeless will also be given prominence in my administration.


PILLAR 5 ENABLERS AND ICT

Will involve the automation and digitalization of operations of the government and the expansion of infrastructures to all the 9 Sub Counties of our County.

CONTEXT

Kisii County borders Nyamira to the Northeast, Narok to the south, and Homa Bay and Migori to the west with a population of about 1.3m people majority being in their youthful age. Kisii is endowed with a rich diversity of natural resources including forests such as Nyangweta, Ritumbe, Ntamocha, Sameta and Mborogo. It has fertile agricultural soils and numerous permanent water sources which include springs, waterfalls and rivers such as Gucha, Nyakomisaro, Riana, Mogusii, Mogonga, Chirichiro and Riyabe.

It has limited mineral deposits key of which are soapstone, granite and ballast.





The county covers an area of 1,323km2 and is part of Kenya's 10 per cent arable land that contributes up to 70 per cent of the country's national commercial agricultural output. Yet it's contribution to the GDP over the last 10 years (2013-2022) has averaged only 2.1%. Given its agro-ecological zone, location within the populous and productive Lake Region Economic Block and the community's famed industry and work ethics, it should be a matter of great concern that Kisii output ranks lowly at a distant 15 among the country's 47 counties.

Kisii County sits right at the centre of the western Kenya tourist circuit that includes the Tabaka soapstone cottage industry, Maasai Mara Game Reserve, Lambwe Valley Game Reserve and the whole of the Lake Victoria Basin. Kisii town is the second largest town in the former Nyanza Province after Kisumu and boasts as the financial hub of the Southern Nyanza region with 15 commercial banks with branches and a Central Bank to crown it all. This makes Kisii a major retail and transit town serving the whole of the former Southern Nyanza region.

According to the Kenya Population and Housing Census Report 2019, Kisii County has a total population of 1,266,860 with 308,054 households consisting of 307,254 conventional households and 800 group quarters. With 957 persons/sq. km in the rural areas and 3,611 persons/sq. km in the urban areas, Kisii is one of the most densely populated counties in Kenya. The poverty prevalence rate is estimated at44.5% which is much higher compared to the national average of 32%. Kisii has also one of the highest age dependency ratios in Kenya of 84.7% compared to the national average of 81.6%.

THE LEGACY PROJECTS

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The following are projects that will mark the legacy of our first term in office.

Implementation of these projects will be masterminded by Kisii Development Council (KDC) that we shall establish in the new county government structure.

HEALTH

WE WILL

Improve the existing facilities by upgrading all the sub-county hospitals to level 5 to provide quality services comparable to the best public facilities in the country.

Develop new facilities to address the geographic inequity in distribution and access to healthcare services especially by needy and vulnerable populations.

Rationalize the staffing needs and invest prudently in the recruitment, capacity building and remuneration of qualified personnel.

Provide basic medical supplies to all the government facilities by streamlining procurement and supply chains with KEMSA and other service providers.

Improve medical services through community health extension services on nutrition and public health.

Improve sanitation in all health facilities by providing clean, reliable water supply and secure sewerage system within the county at all levels.

Establish a performance based contracting for the health workers in order to improve on service delivery.

Establish a cancer research and treatment centre to address the emerging cancer challenge within the region.



EDUCATION, SPORTS, SKILLS AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT

OUR COMMITMENT

Construct and equip ECDE centres with state-of-the-art facilities in all primary schools and designated ECDE centres across the county

Work with the ministry on formulation of the appropriate and requisite Policy Framework to centralize basic education data and provide guidelines for data integration. Timely and reliable data is critical for effective policy decisions, planning and service provision.

Work closely with the national government, Ministry of Education and other stakeholders to improve access, equity, quality, relevance and education financing in primary, secondary and tertiary education.

Improve our education programs in Vocational training, Village Polytechnics and Home craft through infrastructure development, equipping the centres with modern state-of- theart facilities; and hiring highly qualified and motivated tutors on improved terms of service.

Work with all stakeholders to streamline the entire education value chain (ECDE, pre-primary, Primary, Secondary and Tertiary with a special focus on College and TVET). we will hold regular County consultative education transformation forums with all relevant stakeholders (MPs, Teachers etc).

Revamp the administration of the Bursary Fund in order to enhance access to education opportunities by deserving needy students.

All bursaries will be awarded to deserving students purely on merit and that the process is open, transparent, accountable and timely.

Build sports stadia, arts and talent academy studios for skills development and employment creation.

AGRICULTURE

OUR COMMITMENT

Pursue sustainable agricultural development in livestock, fisheries and crop farming by investing in modern agricultural production methods that yields high productivity per unit area.

Revamping and improving agricultural extension services to farmers in order to achieve high productivity.

Collaborate with KALRO and other research institutions for adoption of modern agricultural technology for increased productivity.

Revitalization of the existing key cash crops (tea, coffee, avocado, bananas, pyrethrum, sugarcane) where majority of farmers drive their livelihoods from.

Lobby for subsidized agricultural inputs such as fertilizer, semen, implements and seeds from the state and development partners through appropriate legislation.

Provide agricultural incentives through programs such as one dairy cow per household, one chicken one farmer, hybrid avocados, tissue-culture bananas, pyrethrum splits and fish fingerlings to fish farmers.

Improve dairy breeds through subsidized artificial insemination services.

TRADE, BUSINESS AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

PRIVATE SECTOR

The private sector is the engine of economic growth and development in a market economy. The formal private sector in Kisii is however small and has a narrow base.

OUR COMMITMENT

Expand the current narrow base; attract diaspora investments; aggressive mobilization of both Foreign Direct Investment and domestic savings and investment in key areas through appropriate and targeted incentives.

Reduce some levies and taxes to lower cost of doing business.

Build a multi-purpose shopping mall at Marikiti market that will house market stalls, eateries, ICT centres, social hall for youths to promote talent and art theatres

INFORMAL/SME SECTOR

This sector provides 60% of the employment opportunities in Kisii County which currently is estimated at about 440,000. Most of these are in the transport and jua kali sub-sectors.

OUR COMMITMENT

Unlock the full entrepreneurial and job creation potential of the sector through targeted value addition in agricultural produce, cottage industries and export business.

Enhance access to markets and marketing through the establishment of aggregation centres, restructuring and development of markets starting with the existing ones such as Daraja Mbili & Marikiti, Suneka, Nyakoe, Mogonga, Etago, Nyanguso, Keroka, Keumbu, Riosiri, Tabaka, Nyamache, Magena, Kenyenya, Ogembo, Mosocho, Masimba, Marani and Kegogi.

Operationalise the Kisii County Credit Scheme to offer affordable credit services to entrepreneurs.

Establish and operationalize the Kisii Bodaboda Savings and Credit Cooperative Society
