

Providing Social Protection for vulnerable residents

Creating a caring society

In the next five years, my Government shall focus on social protection programmes in the following areas:

- √ Support for 20,000 vulnerable households through a cash transfer programme.
- √ Provision of health care cover for 20,000 households comprising PWDs, the elderly and ultra-poor who are not covered by the National Government programmes.
- √ Provision of adequate shelter and basic sanitation for 2,000 vulnerable households.
- ✓ Establishment of a specific department responsible for PWDs and orphans, and identification and documentation of all PWDs and organizations (Both formal and informal), currently existing in the County.



√ Regularization of all orphanages in the County plus provision of adequate resources to ensure quality service provision and sustainability.



Transforming Health Care provision

A healthy community is a strong community

- √ Ensure Mandera County Referral Hospital operates optimally with all key departments fully operational.
- √ Ensure the County's patient referral system operates efficiently and effectively, and is fully resourced.
- √ Ensure every location has access to a fully equipped health center with a clinical officer and other qualified health personnel.
- ✓ Ensure all hospitals and health centers are adequately staffed, equipped and supplied with essential drugs and medicine.
- √ Decentralize health care management to sub-county and build the management capacities of health care workers.
- √ Incentivize health care workers through timely promotions, training and improved work environment.

- √ In consultation with County health management, introduce targeted recruitment of health workers to address capacity gaps.
- √ Introduce affordable Universal Health Care scheme to improve access to quality health services for our County residents.
- ✓ Ensure that primary health care provisions across the county are of high standards.
- √ Partner with KEMRI to provide regular training for health care staff to address new diseases.
- √ Invest in maternal, newborn and child health services.
- √ Provide comprehensive health care cover for county employees.





Investing in our children's future

In the next five years, my Government shall:

ECDE

- √ Adequately invest in the infrastructure, learning and teaching resources for early childhood education.
- √ In consultation with parents and other stakeholders, consider the possibility of integrating DUKSI education into County managed ECDE centers.
- √ Initiate and implement feeding programme for pupils in early childhood education.
- √ Employ ECD teachers and managers, and separate the management of ECDE centers from primary schools.

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
Primary & Secondary Education

- √ Decentralize education bursary allocation to improve fairness and reduce double allocation.
- √ Seek partnership between County and National Government, Development Partners and NG-CDF to improve school infrastructure and capacity building of teachers and schools' boards of management

- √ Promote health education in our schools, such as de- worming school children and improving sanitation.
- √ In partnership with the MOE and TSC, recruit up to 1,000 qualified youth for school-based teacher training programmes to address teacher shortages in primary and secondary schools.
- √ In partnership with NG-CDF and development partners, establish/ equip one secondary school according to National School standards in every constituency.
- √ Subsidize parents' contributions to boarding school fees for 10,000 students to a maximum of Sh20,000 per student.

Technical colleges & adult literacy

- √ Launch a countywide adult literacy and continuing education programme to empower communities to play their role in our county's political, social and economic development.
- ✓ Invest in technical colleges' Infrastructure, equipment and expansion of courses.





Ensuring access to potable water for all

Clean water is a human right, not a privilege

- ✓ Build at least six large- scale dams to improve water availability for human and livestock consumption and irrigation.
- ✓ Increase the proportion of people with access to potable water by 20% by 2027.
- √ Scale up and popularise water harvesting techniques and watershed management strategies in the County.

- ✓ Ensure every learning institution in the County has clean water for its learners.
- ✓ Set up an independent study on inter-basin water transfers between the Daua River and Laga Sure catchments/basin.
- √ Implement flood control measures and prepare a hazard map and evacuation plan for towns like Mandera and Rhamu.
- ✓ Ensure all sub-county HQs have clean and accessible water for their residents.

Improving food security for our people

Food insecurity diminishes our development

- √ Provide agricultural input (seed, fertilizers and equipment) as well as subsidies to improve productivity and farm income.
- √ Increase the area under irrigation to 30,000 acres through expansion and rehabilitation of old schemes.
- ✓ Introduce a County Government purchase programme for cereals and other staple crops to incentivize farmers.
- ✓ Deliver sharia-compliant credit facilities for private investors interested in establishing modern agricultural and livestock farming enterprises that support value addition.

- ✓ Expand veterinary and agricultural extension services through investment in human capital and physical infrastructure.
- √ Reduce food insecurity by improving food storage to reduce post-harvest losses.
- √ Intensify research and create more demonstration plots for purposes of building the capacity of farming communities.





Empowering Youth

Harnessing the power and creativity of our County's future

- ✓ Expand the participation of young people in County development and guarantee that 30% of all appointments, projects and budgets specifically target them.
- √ Provide structured support for youth talents development in areas such as the creative arts and sports sectors.
- √ Create at least 2,000 jobs for the youth every year in the informal and formal sectors.
- ✓ Establish Mandera County Youth Empowerment and Development Fund to Support youth-led enterprises and specialized technical skills training opportunities.

- ✓ Establish ICT/Tech hubs in each subcounty to provide opportunities for the youth to access the tech industry.
- √ Establish a partnership with the National Youth Service to provide technical training for our youth to fill identified skills Gaps.





Empowering Women

Equitable Development for Women

- √ Fully implement the two- thirds gender rule to ensure that at least thirty-three per cent (33%) of County Government appointments are women.
- ✓ Establish Mandera County Women Economic Development Fund to provide repayable, sharia-compliant business development loans for women-led and owned small and medium enterprises.
- ✓ Promote girls' study of science, technology,engineering and mathematics (STEM) in our schools through partnership with the national government and development organizations.
- √ Empower and capacity-build women-led organizations and religious groups to address harmful traditional practices.

Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation

Climate change is a threat to our survival

- √ Plant 1,000,000 trees across the County to counter the negative impact of climate change.
- √ Introduce sustainable agro forestry practices to support food security and job creation while protecting the environment.

- ✓ Promote the use of Prosopis *juliflora* as an alternative source of charcoal production to reduce deforestation of local trees.
- √ Promote the recycling of plastic waste and enforce the ban on plastic carrier bags.
- √ Pilot aerial seeding of dryland adapted indigenous grass and sudan grass to improve fodder availability and reduce soil erosion.
- √ Establish large-scale strategic fodder production farms and storage facilities through a public-private partnership to address pasture shortages during drought.

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Investing in growth-oriented industries for wealth creation

- ✓ Establish a directorate under the Ministry of Trade and Industry exclusively responsible for researching, collating, and disseminating information related to agricultural and livestock products value addition.
- ✓ Provide training and study visits opportunities for community groups (especially women and youth) to learn agricultural and livestock value addition.
- √ Prioritise investment in enterprises with the potential to add value to Mandera County products and create jobs.

- ✓ Establish Mandera County Development Authority, to mobilize resources locally, nationally and internationally, and invest in growth-oriented industries in the County.
- ✓ Develop a Public-Private Partnerships
 Framework and engage local, national and international companies, institutions and individuals to invest in County. infrastructure and specific growthoriented industries with job creation potential.

In the next five years, my Government shall:


- ✓ Upgrade all roads in the subcounty headquarters to bitumen standard.
